This is a summary of the annual report for the MIDWEST OPERATING ENGINEERS WELFARE FUND, (Employer Identification No. 36-6109395, Plan No. 501) for the period January 1, 2016 to March 31, 2016. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$473,888,169 as of March 31, 2016 compared to \$462,434,358 as of January 1, 2016. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$11,453,811. This increase includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year, or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$58,134,588. This income included employer contributions of \$44,678,958, employee contributions of \$100,875, realized gains of \$365,831 from the sale of assets, earnings from investments of \$12,988,404 and other income of \$520.

Plan expenses were \$46,680,777. These expenses included \$2,952,314 in administrative expenses and \$43,728,463 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. The items listed below are included in that report:

1. An accountant's report;
2. Financial information and information on payments to service providers;
3. Assets held for investment;
4. Loans or other obligations in default or classified as uncollectible;
5. Transactions in excess of 5 percent of the plan assets; and
6. Information regarding any common or collective trust, pooled separate accounts, master trusts or 103-12 investment entities in which the plan participates.

You also have the right to receive from the plan administrator, on request and at no charge, a statement of the assets and liabilities of the plan and accompanying notes, or a statement of income and expenses of the plan and accompanying notes, or both. If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.
