This is a summary of the annual report for the MIDWEST OPERATING ENGINEERS RETIREMENT ENHANCEMENT FUND, (Employer Identification No. 51-0669630, Plan No. 001) for the period June 1, 2015 to May 31, 2016. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Benefits under the plan are provided by a trust. Plan expenses were \$2,192,211. These expenses included \$831,077 in administrative expenses and \$1,361,134 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 13,995 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$107,292,876 as of May 31, 2016 compared to \$88,444,590 as of June 1, 2015. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$18,848,286. This increase includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year, or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$21,040,497, including employer contributions of \$22,693,714, earnings from investments of \$-2,013,795 and other income of \$360,578.

YOUR RIGHTS TO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. The items listed below are included in that report:

1. An accountant's report;
2. Financial information and information on payments to service providers;
3. Assets held for investment;
4. Fiduciary information, including non-exempt transactions between the plan and parties-in-interest (that is, persons who have certain relationships with the plan);
5. Transactions in excess of 5 percent of the plan assets; and

6. Information regarding any common or collective trust, pooled separate accounts, master trusts or 103-12 investment entities in which the plan participates.

You also have the right to receive from the plan administrator, on request and at no charge, a statement of the assets and liabilities of the plan and accompanying notes, or a statement of income and expenses of the plan and accompanying notes, or both. If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.
